

Introduction

Studiotech was introduced to the scheme by main contractor, ISG, to assist with the detail design and delivery of the external feature lighting throughout the regeneration of the iconic Lime Street development in Liverpool.

Studiotech took the concept by Broadway Malyn and designed a deliverable and achievable scheme within budget and without compromising on quality. The concept included various areas throughout the redevelopment, including the feature lighting to the facade.

Development

The scheme forms the initial elements of Liverpool's ambitious plans for the innovative Knowledge Quarter development. As the Lime Street facade will be one of the first visible aspects of this multi million pound development, it was important that we selected the right luminaires to enhance the dramatic artwork on the aluminium perforated panelled facade.



Solution

We chose to use Traxon Nano Liner Allegro for its durability and reliability. The RGB colour changing luminaires wash boldly across the facade. Each fixture has the capability to be controlled individually which allows for a variety of dynamic lighting effects, ranging from single colour wash to a mixture of colours which allows for the display of daily light shows, to reflect key calendar dates such as St Valentine's Day and global events.

The Studiotech team were required to coordinate with various trades during a phased installation. The completed installation provides an impressive and eye-catching facade to the gateway of a major city centre regeneration that is set out to be a world-class innovation district at the heart of Liverpool city centre.
