CONCEPT The landscape designers' vision to provide a tranquil space for passers-through and residents alike, was further enhanced by dpa lighting, who's scheme includes carefully curated layers of lighting concealed within the soft and hard landscaping elements..



SOLUTION

Studiotech was responsible for implementing the catenary solution at Berol Quarter. Collaborating closely with dpa lighting consultants to develop their initial concept, Studiotech managed the entire engineering process. This included structural calculations, customised fabrication, installation, control and programming.

PRODUCT

Studiotech managed the entire engineering design solution, which included developing custom lanterns based on dpa's original concept. Each lantern was crafted using fabricated aluminium caps with bevelled returns and painted to match the wider project branding; with an outer housing, shaped from clear acrylic, completing the lantern's distinct look. These unique lanterns not only complement the development's branding but also serve as a functional light source.

EXPERIENCE

The suspended catenary lanterns above the public space not only enhance the vibrancy of the new neighbourhood but also echo the branding and ambiance of Berol Quarter, evoking a sense of familiarity for those who pass through.
